He is recognized as one of the world's leading experts on human factors in the aviation and space fields.

Clay has served on numerous government and industry technical advisory committees, including NASA's Aerospace Safety Advisory Panel and as Chairman of the U.S. Air Transport Association Operations Council; he currently is on the Board of Governors of the Flight Safety Foundation. He is an experienced presenter and has published extensively in the aerospace human factors field. His academic achievements include a B.A. from Duke University, and a Ph.D. in Social Psychology from the University of Texas.
